1. About mTrader

Get streaming data from more than 50 exchanges in realtime, specialist data and news with mTrader

Infront's mTrader is a convenient way to follow the markets in realtime anywhere you are with your iPhone. Infront provides realtime market data from more than 50 exchanges and several news agencies. With mTrader you get instant access to the same markets as your The Online Trader subscription.

Benefits

- Access to the markets anywhere
- Realtime streaming quotes
- Create your own lists of instruments
- Combine data from different markets

Available sources

mTrader contains information from several sources; Exchanges and News agencies in realtime. You will have access to the same realtime sources as in you're "The Online Trader" subscription. See www.theonlinetrader.com for more information.

Subscription fee

As a customer of The Online Trader, you can subscribe to mTrader for a small additional fee each month. You do not have to pay extra exchange fees to use mTrader, since the solution use the same login server and you can only be logged in one place at a time. This makes the service especially cost efficient.

2. Installation

- Go to App Store on you iPhone.
- Search for "mTrader".
- Install the application by clicking "Free" and then "Install app".
- Installation starts as soon as you type in your password for the App Store.
- When installation is complete, launch mTrader by clicking icon.

3. Login

- A. Click on the mTrader icon on you iPhone to start the program
- B. Go to the "Settings" tab in the bottom right corner of the app.
- C. Enter your user name and password (same as for The Online Trader)
- D. Click "Done" and go back to the "My List" tab.

If you get the message "Login Failed" go back to step C and be sure to enter the correct username and password. If you still get the message "Login Failed", you might

not have access to the mTrader service. For help on how to add additional services, see www.theonlinetrader.com/support/

After the first successful login, your iPhone will remember your username and password.

3.1. Connection options

mTrader can connect via WiFi or 3G. The connection is controlled by the “Settings” in the main menu of your iPhone.

4. Main menu

The main menu includes the following:

- My List
 - Symbol details
 - Chart
 - Trades
 - Orderbook
 - News
- News
- Settings

4.1. My List

Your selected Symbols will be displayed here.

To edit your list you can either upload a list from The Online Trader (see separate section) or go to the “+” button in the top right corner of your screen.

Symbols can be browsed inside the list using your finger to swipe up or down the screen.

From the “My List” screen you can access more detailed view of the Symbols by tapping the Symbol you want to see.

By tapping column headings you can change the displayed column values.

- Column 1 can be toggled between: Last, Bid and Ask
- Column 2 can be toggled between: %change, +/-change and Last

Delete Symbols in your list by tapping “Edit”, “-” beside the Symbol you want to delete and then “Delete”.

4.1.1. Symbol View

The Symbol View display is split into 4 sections: Chart, Details, Orderbook and News.

4.1.1.1. Chart

Chart displays: Last, +/- change, %change, timestamp and 1y chart.

By tapping the chart section in Symbol details, you get a full screen chart. The selection of charts is displayed at the bottom of the screen (1day, 1month and 1year).

4.1.1.2. Symbol Details

Symbol displays: Open, high, low, VWAP, volume, trades, turnover, B lot, B lot value, avg. volume and avg. value.

Tap the “Symbol Details” section gives you a view of the last 25 trades in the Symbol you have selected.

4.1.1.3. Orderbook

Orderbook displays: The top 5 levels in the orderbook. (This is restricted by your level of access to the orderbook in your subscription.)

Tapping the orderbook section gives you the remaining levels in the orderbook you have access to (mTrader version 1.1 is limited to 5 levels. Future versions will have more levels).

4.1.1.4. News

News displays: This view displays the last 3 news articles today linked to the Symbol you are looking at.

Tapping the news section will display up to 25 news articles today linked to the Symbol.

You can read the whole news article by tapping the news header.

4.2. News

The news tab displays the last 50 news articles from your news feeds.

Scroll through the list of news articles by swiping your finger up or down the screen.

To see the whole new article, tap the news heading you want to read.

If you want to see articles from only one news provider, tap “Feeds” in the top left corner of your screen, and select the news provider you want to see.

New articles are automatically added at the top of the screen as they are added. You can also refresh the list manually by tapping the “Refresh” button in the top right corner of the screen.

4.3. Settings

The settings screen is where you input your user details. (The same user info as you use in The Online Trader.)

5. Upload watch-list from The Online Trader

With a subscription to mTrader you can define a list of Symbols in The Online Trader and upload it to mTrader with a click of a button.

From The Online Trader, open a Composite Window, define your Symbol list dragging symbols from Market windows or typing the symbol name in the search box. Select “Upload to mTrader” action from the toolbar in the Composite Window. When you start mTrader your new watch list will be displayed in “My List”.
